Haven House predominantly looks after and supports children and young people who have life-limiting or life-threatening conditions, as well as their families. Care is provided at the hospice itself in Woodford Green as well as in

the community. Haven House needs to raise £4.4 million a year to achieve this. The work done by

Haven House is impressive but the strength, love and attitude with which it is done is what is really overwhelming.
